History:

Family owned and operated company which was established in 1963 on 60 hectares of land. Three generations have worked to expand the farm to over 2,100 hectares of land it farms today. Alfalfa hay cube production began in 1968. In 2001, the company added hay compressing to its activities, exporting to Japan, Korea, China and the Middle East. Eckenberg Farms can export approximately 150,000 metric tons per year through the ports of Seattle and Tacoma.

Facilities:

Cubing: 6 Machines - 300 metric tons per day production volume

Capabilities: 100% alfalfa, sliced cube and mixed feed cubes in bulk, 30 kg bags or 500 kg totes.

Hay Presses

- 1 Series 9000 Hunterwood compressor
- 1 Eckenberg built Sleeve Bale compressor
- 1 Simpson Sleeve Bale compressor

Capabilities: Slicing farm-level big bales and double compressing into 480-kg sleeve bales, 120-kg long bales, 60-kg bales or 30-kg half-cut bales.

Storage Capacity:

Hay Cube Storage Barns	2 X 4,500 MT = 9,000 MT
Specialty Cube Storage Barns	2 X 1,500 MT = 3,000 MT
Raw Material Sheds	8 X 2,000 MT = 10,000 MT
